# <u>Safety:</u>

Children must be collected on time at the end of the school day.

It is parents' responsibility to inform the school in writing of changes in name, address, or phone number. We also need a 2nd contact number for emergencies. We will then be able to contact you immediately if your child is sick.

## Child Protection and Welfare:

The Department of Education and Science have produced Guidelines and Procedures for all schools in relation to Child Protection and Welfare.
